Terry Gibson moved and Greg Delzeit seconded a motion to approve the Temporary Extension of Premise application for Kirkwood & Co., July 24, 2021, and recommend the temporary extension permit fee be \$25 for a charitable not-for-profit fundraising event and \$100 for profit. Motion carried 4-0

Following discussion regarding the newly mandated Revenue Neutral Rate (SB 13/HB 2104) for establishing the 2022 budget, Marty Allen moved and Greg Delzeit seconded a motion to approve notifying the Doniphan County Clerk by July 20th of the city's intent to exceed the revenue neutral rate by three (3) mills. The Doniphan County Clerk provided the RNR at 36.896. Motion carried 4-0


