Mayor Batchelder opened the regular city council meeting at 5:00 p.m.

Tana Snyder moved and Keith Edmonds seconded a motion to approve the regular city council meeting minutes of November 9, 2022 and special city council meeting minutes of November 30, 2022. Motion carried 5-0

Tana Snyder moved and Keith Edmonds seconded a motion to approve the bills as presented. Motion carried 5-0

Brian Kingsley, BG Consultants, reviewed the street improvement project, explained the completed Phase 1 portion and provided a number of options for bid in the Phase 2 portion. Mr. Kingsley explained change order #1 that reduces the contract price by \$36,772.58 which reflects the scrub seal not done by Vance Brothers and the crack seal that will be completed in Phase 2 and expecting a change order #2. Also explained the Contractor's Application for Payment, \$103,740.46, to be signed by the mayor. Terry Gibson moved and Tana Snyder seconded a motion to approve change order #1 and the Contractor's Application for Payment #1 in the amount of \$103,740.46. Motion carried 5-0 Following further discussion of Option No. 5 which is projected to be \$18,479.43 over budget, Terry Gibson moved and Keith Edmonds seconded a motion to move forward to bid Option No. 5 with the alternative as discussed. Motion carried 5-0

Water/Sewer Superintendent Saunders – Explained the needed street signs will cost \$170; a 4" clean check valve cost is \$220 and either purchase new flag poles or repair/make new poles for the street light poles. Maintenance can make the flag poles if a new welder is purchase from Harbor Freight, \$1,015.48. Terry Gibson moved and Keith Edmonds seconded a motion for W/S Supt. Saunders to purchase street signs, \$170 total; check valve, \$220 total; and presented welder from Harbor Freight, \$1,015.48 total. Motion carried 5-0 (Supt. has bids on file)

Unsafe Structures Update – Attorney Collins provided a brief summary to date. North Kansas St/Coronado Rd Culvert – Attorney Collins will be in communications with the county.

Mower – W/S Supt. Saunders has bids from several companies ranging up to \$16,000 for a zero-turn mower. W/S Supt. Saunders is suggesting a Ventrac, \$29,900 plus various attachments for various costs for mowing the lagoon area. Following discussion, the consensus was for W/S Supt. to schedule a demo and review options available for financing.

Tana Snyder moved and Keith Edmonds seconded a motion to approve contractor's (BRB Contractors, Inc.) application for payment #6, \$213,024.62. Motion carried 5-0

Clerk Karn explained the projected BCBS cost increase of health/dental insurance at approximate 55%. Following discussion, the consensus of the council is to search new available options and bring back in January 2023.

Tana Snyder moved and Keith Edmonds seconded a motion to add Debra Keebler as an authorized signer on all of the city's accounts beginning January 1, 2023. Motion carried 5-0

W/S Supt. Saunders stated cold patch may be needed.
