The Highland Community Action Team (H-CAT) impacts not only our community, but also the surrounding communities of Doniphan County. Meals on Wheels serves families in White Cloud, Denton, Severance, and Bendena which H-CAT helps to secure the volunteers to deliver meals 5 days a week to these towns.

H-CAT organizes activities for holidays. On the 4th of July, H-CAT has an entry in the parade, ice cream social at the community center, and helps with fireworks. They organize an annual Memorial Day service. Around Christmas time, H-CAT sponsors outdoor decorating/lighting contests. They are instrumental with the street and park decorations. H-CAT sponsors the annual Snowflake Festival with the cooperation of local businesses and organizations which provides an evening of fun, food and crafting for children and parents. H-CAT works alongside the Highland Fire Department on a "Breakfast with Santa," including games, activities and photos with Santa and Mrs. Clause.

Many hours are spent beautifying the town with planters on the streets and flower pods in Degginger Park. Trees have been planted and shrubs trimmed. H-CAT cooperates with the city in the annual town clean-up. Some of the projects of the past have included: street banners, trash receptacles, planters, playground equipment, help with the community building and the welcome sign. The entire community is always involved in special benefit dinners, appreciation dinners, and celebrations. All ages work together to accomplish the many goals planned for the year.

The "Yard of the Month" winner will be announced beginning the last of May and continue to be announced at the end of every month until fall.

H-CAT participates with many other vendors at the Highland Community Market which is held on the first and third Saturday from 9:00 A.M. until noon, beginning the first Saturday in May, and located west of Degginger Park. Each market date has a children's story time and crafts along with snow cones. Also, H-CAT collects aluminum cans for recycling which can be brought to the market. All are encouraged to come, enjoy, and buy.
