

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND, KANSAS TO LEVY A PROPERTY TAX RATE EXCEEDING THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE;

WHEREAS, the Revenue Neutral Rate for the City of Highland was calculated as 35.939 mills by the Doniphan County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the budget proposed by the Governing Body of the City of Highland will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body held a hearing on September 14, 2022 allowing all interested taxpayers desiring to be heard an opportunity to give oral testimony; and


WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Highland having heard testimony, still finds it necessary to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND

The City of Highland shall levy a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate of 35.939 mills.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Governing Body.
